

TERMS OF SERVICE & DISCLAIMER

MEHTORVDL & MEHTORAPI [VDL MODULE]

Last Updated: June 2026

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Please read these Terms of Service carefully before accessing, deploying, or utilizing the MehtorVDL application or the MehtorAPI (specifically the VDL integration module). By using these services, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agreed to be legally bound by these terms. If you do not agree, you are prohibited from using the service.

1. ACCEPTANCE AND SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This document constitutes a legally binding agreement between the end-user (hereinafter referred to as "the User") and Mehtor (accessible via mehtor.ru, hereinafter referred to as "the Provider"). This agreement governs the use of the **MehtorVDL** software client and the multi-functional **MehtorAPI [VDL]** streaming and data routing interface (collectively referred to as "the Service").

2. TECHNICAL NATURE AND ARCHITECTURE OF THE SERVICE

The Service functions purely as a technical conduit, parser, and real-time data routing interface designed to facilitate user-initiated caching, media streaming, and legal content transmission from publicly accessible third-party URLs. The Provider explicitly outlines that:

- The Service does not maintain permanent storage, servers for hosting, or indexes of media assets downloaded or streamed by Users.
- The Service functions dynamically at the specific, real-time command of the User.
- The Provider does not perform pre-moderation, review, or filtering of the Uniform Resource Locators (URLs) inputted into the Service, and has no knowledge of the specific data passing through the routing API.

3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND FAIR USE LIABILITY

The User retains absolute and exclusive legal and civil liability for any data, streaming assets, or media downloaded via the Service. By executing any request through MehtorVDL or MehtorAPI, the User explicitly represents and warrants that:

- The material being accessed or downloaded is the exclusive intellectual property of the User, falls within the Public Domain, or is processed under recognized "Fair Use" doctrines (e.g., for non-commercial personal archiving, educational review, or critique purposes).
- The User has obtained explicit, verified authorization from the respective copyright holder if such authorization is legally required by applicable jurisdiction.
- The User will indemnify and hold harmless the Provider against any claims, losses, or legal challenges arising from unauthorized distribution or reproduction of proprietary material.

4. THIRD-PARTY PLATFORMS & TERMS OF SERVICE

The Service is completely independent and autonomous. Mehtor is not affiliated with, endorsed by, sponsored by, or associated with any third-party video hosting networks, social media platforms, or content distributors (including but not

limited to YouTube, TikTok, Twitch, Vimeo, or Meta platforms). The User is solely responsible for reading, understanding, and adhering to the respective Terms of Service of any target third-party platform from which they request data routing.

5. DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES ("AS IS")

THE SERVICE IS PROVIDED ON AN "AS IS" AND "AS AVAILABLE" BASIS WITHOUT WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED.

While the Provider employs rigorous administrative effort to maintain high technical stability (targeting an operational uptime between 97.89% and 99.97%), the Provider makes no guarantees that:

- The Service will be entirely uninterrupted, error-free, secure, or compatible with future algorithmic updates implemented by third-party web platforms.
- The extraction parameters or data streams provided by MehtorAPI will remain uniform across all network changes.

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, the Provider shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, punitive, or consequential damages, or loss of data resulting from the use or temporal inability to use the Service.

6. ACCEPTABLE USE AND RATE LIMITING

Users and API consumers agree not to exploit the Service to engage in malicious activities, including Distributed Denial of Service (DDoS) attacks, automated brute-forcing, or systematic infrastructure overload. The Provider reserves the right to enforce automated rate-limiting, block specific IP subnets, or terminate access keys without prior notice if abnormal or malicious resource consumption is detected.

7. COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT & ABUSE POLICY (DMCA WORKFLOW)

The Provider respects legitimate intellectual property rights. Because the Service does not host, index, or replicate files, the Provider cannot "delete" files from the Internet. However, as an expression of good faith and cooperation, the Provider operates a strict blocking workflow:

1. **Submission:** Copyright holders or authorized representatives may submit abuse notices or system restriction requests to: **customers@mehtor.online**.
2. **Review:** Legitimate requests will be processed within forty-eight (48) to seventy-two (72) business hours.
3. **Remediation:** Upon validation, the Provider's sole remediation metric is the implementation of network-level filters within MehtorAPI to completely block the processing, parsing, or routing of specific URL patterns, video identifiers, or proprietary domains.
